



## 1. Restrictions and Safety Instructions of Parallel Arm

- This equipment is designed for industrial applications.
- The Counterbalancing characteristics of the Parallel Arm decreases when the angle of Parallel Arm is less than 60°. Tighten the clamping levers if you need to operate the Parallel Arm outside this range.




Don't stand in front of the arm during assembly. The force from the gas springs can launch the front part with high speed!



- Use a mild detergent and a soft cleaning tissue to clean the instrument.
- Only use accessories provided or approved by Optilia.

## 2. Description of parts

The Parallel Arm is designed for table-top or wall-mounted applications. The Parallel Arm design provides stable and smooth operation together with W10x or W20x High Definition cameras. Two gas springs balance the load of the camera. It is intended for vertical operations and is especially suitable for large area access applications.





# 3. Assembly Instructions

- a. The parallel arm is delivered locked in its arresting latch. Keep the equipment in this position until the camera is being attached.
- b. Fasten the table stand (1) onto the table by the Clamp (2).
- c. Fix the set collar (9) using 4mm allen key approximately 10-20cm from surface of the working bench.
- d. Place the locked Parallel Arm on vertical post of the table stand. Be careful the Rotational movement friction screw (6) is not blocking vertical post of the stand
- e. Attach the Camera to the articulated Knuckle (8).




f. Fix the Camera Cable using the plastic ties (10) at the 4 positions shown in below picture! Tilt and angle Camera in all directions and make sure the Cable stays relaxed. Cut the excess tie tails!



**Note:** Refer to user's instructions of the knuckle to learn more about how to use this item.

#### 4. How to operate the device

- a. Carefully unlock the Parallel Arm from the arresting latch (4) and move the camera to its working position.
- b. Turn the clamping levers (5) clockwise for more friction or tighten them to lock the Parallel Arm in position.
- c. Tighten the knob (6) for more rotational movement friction if necessary.



d. Leverage power of the gas springs is preset for W10x-HD or W20x-HD. However, you can change this by using the arresting knobs (3) if necessary. Turn the knob (3) counter clockwise to increase the strength. Turn the knob clockwise to reduce the strength.

**Note:** Working distance range of W10x-HD and W20x-HD cameras is approximately 190-245 mm at maximum zoom factor without extra close-up lenses. Camera cannot focus if you position the device outside this range.

Operation Temperature / Humidity • - 0°C ~+45°C / Rh. 0~90% (No condensing)



Dimensions of table stand base ● ~ 125(W)x125(D) mm.

Weight ● ~ 8 kg (inclusive table stand and table clamp)
